## What is P3P?

- P3P is a one-time online questionnaire for newly diagnosed prostate cancer patients.
- P3P will ask you a series of questions, then build a personalized profile with information to help educate and prepare you for your conversation with your doctor about your prostate cancer treatment options.

## How do I complete P3P?



### Prior to your next visit with your doctor:

1. Go to [p3p4me.org](http://p3p4me.org)
2. Select "I am a man with prostate cancer"
3. Select "Create new account" and input the requested information
4. Complete P3P
5. To view and print your P3P report, navigate to the "Report for My Doctor" tab (you may need to scroll down the page and select "next step" or "skip ahead to..." to access this tab)
6. Select "Print Report"
