

## **Pain-control Optimization Pathway after Ureteroscopy**

Medication	Dose	Route of Administration	Duration of Therapy	
Recommendation: Intraoperative				
<b>NSAIDs</b> e.g. Ketorolac	30mg	IV	Procedure Only	
Recommendation: Postoperative Bundle				
<b>NSAIDs</b> e.g. Ketorolac	10mg	oral	Q6 x 5 days (20 tablets)	
<b>α-blockers</b> e.g. Tamsulosin	0.4mg	oral	QD (duration of stent or 30 days)	
Anticholinergic e.g. Oxybutynin XL	10mg	oral	QD (duration of stent)	
Acetaminophen*	650mg	oral	Q6h PRN	
Optional: Postoperative				
Pyridium	200mg	oral	PRN x 3 days	

<sup>\*</sup>do not exceed 3000 mg of acetaminophen in a 24 hour period



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<b>Medication Recommendations</b>	Contraindications		
Recommendation: Intraoperative and Postoperative			
NSAIDs e.g. Ketorolac	Allergy Acute renal failure Creatinine ≥ 1.9 325 mg Aspirin: concurrent chronic NSAIDs use Gastric bypass Irritable bowel disease (IBS) Peptic ulcer disease Coronary artery bypass grafting (CABG) - within 30 days Anti-coagulant therapy**		
Anticholinergic e.g. Oxybutynin XL	Closed-angle glaucoma Gastroparesis Myasthenia gravis Concurrent use of potassium salts • (potassium chloride/potassium citrate) Urinary retention
