Low Risk: pT1 Grade 1/2

Intermediate Risk: pT1 Grade 3/4; or pT2 any Grade

High Risk: pT3 any Grade; pT4; pN1; sarcomatoid/ rhabdoid; and/ or macroscopic positive margin

Abdominal Imaging: To assess for post-op complications, renal function, and/or recurrence; **CT preferred; MRI if GFR <30;** consider **US** for de-escalating surveillance, poor renal function, MRI intolerance

Chest Imaging: CT preferred for HR, CXR for LR
